

Ryde Lake Family Camping Information and Guidelines - 2012

The following guidelines are for your safety and enjoyment.

1. **Arrival:** Arrival check-in is after 3 pm. Check-in at dining hall. Dinner is included on arrival day. Balance of fee is payable at check-in. Payment by cheque is preferred, made payable to Ryde Lake Camp.
2. **Departure:** Departure is by 2 pm (check-out from cabins by 12 pm) Lunch is included on the departure day. Please note: additional charges may be incurred for late departures
3. **Meal times are: Breakfast 8:30 am Lunch 12:30 pm Dinner 5:30 pm**
Picnic lunches are available for campers who are hiking on our site (4 hr. notice please). The daily meal rate is a flat fee and includes three meals. No refund for missed meals. Please let us know in advance of any vegetarian needs.
4. **Day Visitors** are charged a daily rate of \$5.00 plus meals and may be accommodated if numbers allow.
5. **Accommodation** is in our cabins.
6. **Telephone:** 705-687-2912. Please note that camp phone is intended for camp business and emergency only.
7. **Parking:** In the interest of camp safety, we ask that all vehicles, once unloaded, be parked in the designated parking areas at the dining hall.
8. **Waterfront:** For your safety, swim in the designated area only. No swimming or watercraft activity after sunset. Waterfront is unsupervised. Families are responsible for their own safety. Children must be accompanied by an adult (18 yrs and over).
9. **Fishing:** For swimmer safety, there is no fishing from the waterfront docks. We can suggest other suitable areas. Be advised that "Ontario Recreation Fishing Regulations" apply to all fishing. We encourage "catch and release" practices.
10. **Canoes, kayaks, paddleboats, lifejackets, and paddles** are provided.
Lifejackets must be worn when using any watercraft on our site: boats, canoes, kayaks, or paddleboats.
11. **The Natural Environment:** Please do your part to help preserve Ryde for the future. Leave flowers and plants for others to enjoy. Protect and do not disturb wildlife.
"Leave only your thanks and take nothing but photographs and memories." Enjoy!
12. **Campfires:** Campfire Rock, dining hall, and waterfront firepit areas are available for evening campfires. Due to the proximity of the waterfront firepit to the sleeping cabins, we ask that it's use be restricted to before 9:45 pm. If you are planning for your fire to go later, may we suggest using the Campfire Rock or dining hall firepits. Firewood is available from the wood shelter near dining hall firepit.
13. **Noise:** In consideration of others, no excessive noise after 10 pm.
14. **Ryde Lake Camp is an alcohol-free site.**
15. **Smoking in designated areas only:** Picnic tables outside kitchen and by paddle hut. Cans are provided for butts.
16. **Laundry facilities** are not available to campers.
17. **Kitchen facilities:** For use of kitchen staff only. Due to public health regulations we are unable to provide freezer/fridge space for camper's personal use.
18. **Garbage and Recycling:** Please help keep our site clean by depositing litter in the appropriate containers.
19. **No pets please**
20. **Ryde Lake Camp is not responsible for accidents or property loss.**
